SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

2017 – 2018 School Year

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SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW:

The BYU Management Society - St. George Chapter has established a scholarship program available to students pursuing post-secondary education at any four year institution of higher learning in the State of Utah, BYU Idaho or BYU Hawaii. Monies will be paid directly to the recipients' school of choice to help defray the cost of tuition. Preference will be given to students pursuing business related education. The BYU Management Society – St. George Chapter will award the following scholarships for the 2016 – 2017 academic year:

1. Six (6) scholarships of \$750 each will be awarded to graduating high school seniors from the Washington County School District. Eligible high schools in the Washington County School District include Dixie, Snow Canyon, Pine View, Hurricane, Desert Hills, Enterprise, Millcreek, and Tuacahn.
2. Two (2) scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded to students from Washington County, UT who are enrolled as a Junior, Senior, or Graduate Student in the BYU Marriott School of Management or equivalent acceptance at BYU-Idaho or BYU-Hawaii.

DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS:

Upon award selection, The BYU Management Society – St. George Chapter will issue a check directly to the designated school. The scholarship award must be used in the 2017 – 2018 academic year (*Includes Fall 2017, Winter/Spring 2018, Summer 2018*). Exceptions will be made if individual chooses to serve a mission beforehand. Scholarship recipients may be required to submit proof of enrollment and upcoming class schedules to The BYU Management Society. Scholarship recipients may also be required to submit to The BYU Management Society a copy of their tuition expense receipt.

SUBSEQUENT SCHOLARSHIPS:

Scholarship recipients are welcome to reapply for scholarships in subsequent academic years assuming they continue to meet all of the scholarship requirements. Previous scholarship recipients must submit a separate application for each subsequent award. Previous awards do not guarantee subsequent award selection.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

Applicants are responsible to ensure that all application materials and requirements are submitted to The BYU Management Society – St. George Chapter no later than **April 1, 2017**. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

NOTIFICATION:

Scholarship recipients will be notified by April 30, 2016. Scholarship recipients will be selected by a scholarship committee comprised of board members of The BYU Management Society – St. George Chapter and other appointed individuals. All decisions of the scholarship committee will be final.

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QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must meet all of the following requirements to be considered for an award.

1. Applicants must submit an official school transcript reflecting a grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.25.
2. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior from a Washington County School District high school who has been accepted for enrollment at BYU-Provo, BYU-Idaho, BYU-Hawaii, or any other four-year institution in the State of Utah, or a graduate of a Washington County School District high school and who is currently enrolled as a Junior, Senior or Graduate Student in the BYU Marriott School of Management or the equivalent in the BYU-Idaho or BYU-Hawaii Business Programs.
3. Applicants must be a United States Citizen or legal resident.
4. Each application should be typed, but will be accepted if hand written in a neat, legible format.
5. Applicants must state a desired major and preference will be given to those seeking degrees in business. (Accounting, Business Management, Information Systems, Marketing, Finance, Entrepreneurship, etc.)
6. All application materials (application, transcript, and letters of recommendation) must be submitted no later than **April 1, 2017** in a 9 in. x 12 in. envelope with the applicant's name and BYU Management Society Scholarship written on the exterior of the envelope. If additional space is needed for any questions, submit additional sheets of paper referencing applicable questions.
